The 45th Annual America's Finest City Half Marathon & 5K is coming up on **Sunday, August 21**. The half marathon will start at 6:15 a.m. at the Cabrillo National Monument and end in Balboa Park and the 5K will start at 6:10 a.m. in Balboa Park.

Your residence or business may be impacted by this race between 6 and 9:30 a.m. as the streets listed to the right will be closed to traffic at various times during that period.

Please plan ahead to avoid any disruption of your Sunday morning activities. We encourage you to participate in this nationally recognized event by cheering on the runners as they pass by. The entrants include a number of world class runners as well as your friends and neighbors.
